There will be no Wednesday Night Supper or Wednesday night programming this week. Our regular Wednesday night meal and programming will resume on January 6, 2016.

The church office will be closed this Thursday and Friday in observance of the New Year holiday.

Beginning in January church office hours will be Monday – Thursday from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. The office will be closed on Fridays.

The Session has called a congregational meeting for Sunday, January 10th, immediately following worship. The purpose of the meeting is to vote on the Pastor's Terms of Call for 2016.

The Property Committee and Session have approved a new building security plan which is being implemented in several phases. The plan will change the way we access our main building (not Wilson Hall) by limiting access to two entryways – the main office door and the entrance doors beside the kitchen. These doors will be fitted with electronic locks which will be accessed using 4-digit number codes. Each individual requiring access to the buildings will be assigned a 4-digit numeric code. With the increased rate of unauthorized entry that we have had over the last few years, we feel this is a necessary step to protect our property and ensure a safe facility for our staff, members, and building users.
