In the interest of continuing to be good stewards of the church and the budget, we would like to implement emailed quarterly contribution statements to any members who would prefer receiving their quarterly contribution reports via email. The final, year-end report used for your tax reporting would still be sent as a hard copy via U. S. Mail in early January. If you are interested in

receiving the quarterly report via email, please send a note to Mary McGee at office@tuckahoepres.org to "opt in" to this new practice. Be sure to send the request from the email you would like your report sent to so that we can insure we have the most up-to-date information.

In an effort to increase participation in our church's leadership, inspire increased lay participation in the ministry, and enable the Session to function as a more responsive body, the membership of Tuckahoe is being asked to act on two recommendations from Session. The first was to set a range for the Session membership to 12-19 members. The purpose of this recommendation is to allow flexibility for the Session to function with fewer members than previously mandated. Our hope is that we can reduce the number of Elders to two per committee over the course of a few years while simultaneously increasing the number of lay members on each committee, thus furthering one of our central tenets, The Priesthood of all Believers. This recommendation was presented at the congregational meeting on May 15 and was approved. The second recommendation is to reduce the term length of Elders and Deacons from three to two years. This will be presented for vote at the congregational meeting on July 10th immediately following worship. This action is based on the Nominating Committee's observation that there is often a hesitancy to commit to a three year term of service. The hope is that by reducing the initial commitment, members will be more willing to serve and be re-elected for subsequent terms. Our Church constitution, the Book of Order stipulates a maximum of three year terms with no stated minimum (G-2.0404). Officers will still be able to serve the same number of consecutive years (6) by serving three two-year terms instead of two three-year terms.
