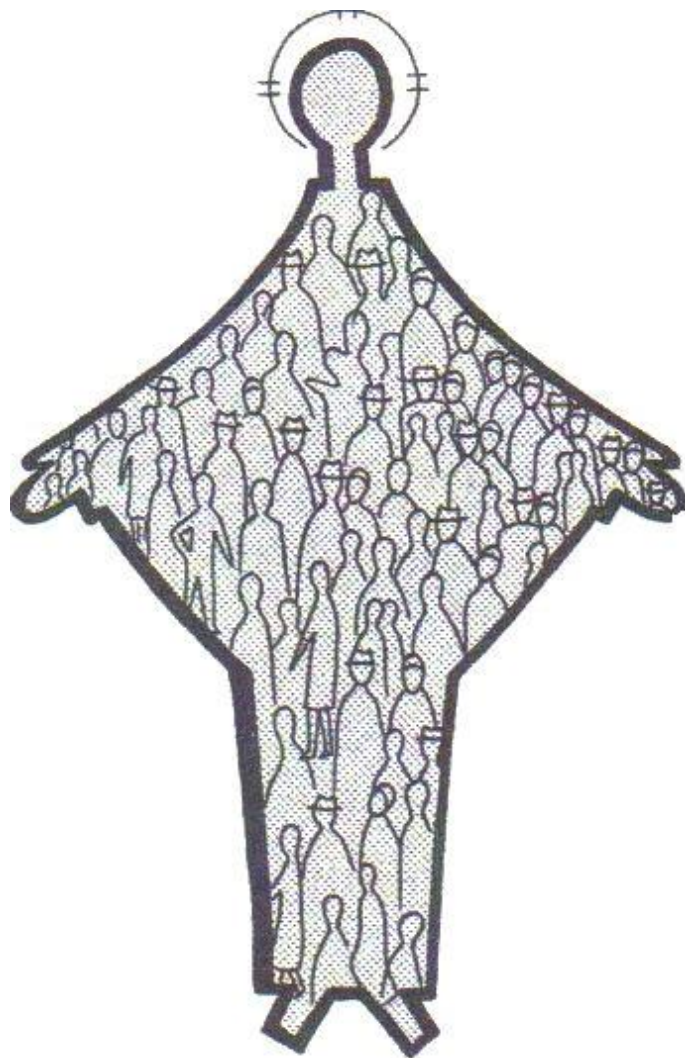
*PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Following dinner this week there will be an Ash Wednesday Service in the sanctuary. The service this year will blend the traditional Ash Wednesday observance with elements of healing and wholeness. Instead of personal petitions for healing, we will ask you to write up your desire for the healing for our nation and the world which you will then place on the cross in the front of the sanctuary after you receive your ashes. Begin your Lenten journey with this important reminder, gathered with others in this place so together we may commit our journey toward the new life we celebrate on Easter morn.

The discipline of self-examination and prayer are central features of Lent. But those disciplines should not stop at Easter. In the spirit of “building on Lent” we should integrate those disciplines into our journey with Christ. In an effort to do this, we will make available to you “Prayer Request” cards, which will be found inside new blue-covered friendship pads in the pews. We encourage everyone to make use of these for personal or corporate petitions or thanksgivings. At the bottom of the card, you may indicate whether you would like the Pastor, the Prayer Group, and/or the Deacons (it may be any one, two, or all three) to pray for your request. You will then place your request in a secured box on the table in the Narthex nearest Duntreath Hall. Pastor Dennis will open the box on Mondays and distribute the cards as indicated. God hears the prayers of God’s people and we look forward to hearing how hearts and lives are impacted by this new ministry.
