Next Sunday, September 10th we return to our regular worship time of 11:00 a.m. Sunday School for all ages will also resume that morning at 9:30 a.m. We will celebrate the sacrament of the Lord's Supper during worship and we will be dedicating our choir and instruments in worship to the glory of God. We look forward to celebrating the gifts God has given us through our music ministry.

Blessing of the Backpacks - The school year brings with it joy, new friends, new adventures, hope, concern, a bit of uncertainty and a whole new journey--not just for students, but teachers, parents and those who work in schools and out of schools. Scripture reminds us in Deuteronomy 31: 8 "It is the Lord who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not fail you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed." As we enter this school year, we invite all teachers, students of all ages, and those who work to bring a bag with them to worship Sunday, September 10 as we say a special blessing over the bags we take on the journey with us. We will be giving out special tags to hang on your bag as a reminder of God's presence and Tuckahoe's loving care.

Next Sunday we also kick off the Youth Group program for the year. Youth Group will begin at 5:30 p.m., with dinner ending our time together at 6:30 p.m. Our first dinner will be pot luck- so please bring a dish to share! All youth, grades 6-12, are encouraged to come together during Youth Group to understand how our faith forms all the parts of our lives and how we can be servants for Christ-- through laughter, games and conversation. There are some wonderful trips, games, and adventures planned for the year.

Next Sunday, and every second Sunday of the month, we collect non-perishable food items for the Lamb's Basket food pantry. You may bring your donations to the church at any time during the month. Tuesday morning prayer continues every Tuesday at 9:30 a.m. in the church parlor for a half hour of weekly time of prayer. The prayer group will begin a study of David Timm's book "Living the Lord's Prayer" on September 12th. This book takes a careful look at the words used in this familiar prayer. Through this resource, we hope to understand more deeply how life transforming it can be. After a time of study, we will spend time in prayer for our congregation. All are welcome to join us!

This year the children of Tuckahoe will have new worship bags. Each child has their very own bag to bring into worship with them, and they have even had a chance to decorate those bags in their own unique way. The bags will be hung across from the Resource Center on some wonderful new hooks. These bags are meant not as a way to distract children from worship, but aid in children's learning and absorbing worship. They will have coloring pages, listening pages, note taking pages, and best of all, each child can fill them with whatever they need to help them stay focused and attentive during worship. We are excited about our new bags. We hope you will enjoy seeing children joyfully attend worship.
